COMPLAINT

The Complainant, being duly sworn, makes complaint to the above-named Court and states that there is probable cause to believe that the Defendant committed the following offense(s). The complainant states that the following facts establish PROBABLE CAUSE:

Complainant, Robert Dale, of the Minneapolis Police Department, has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On or about September 28, 2013, at approximately 2:09 a.m., Minneapolis police responded to shots fired in the area of the Blue Nile Nightclub, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Upon arrival, police observed evidence of numerous gunshots. There were several discharged bullet casings in the area and cars with bullet holes in them. Investigation revealed that there had been an altercation inside the Blue Nile that spilled over into an adjacent parking lot. At some point, two groups outside began shooting at one another.

During the shootout, two identified males (Victim 1 and Victim 2) were approached by one of the shooters, a black male wearing a red shirt. This male shot Victim 2 in the chest. Victim 1 attempted to run from the suspect, who then shot Victim 1 in the leg. Victim 1 was able to limp to a nearby fire station. Victim 2 only made it a few more yards before he collapsed. Victim 2 was dead when emergency personnel arrived on the scene. Subsequent medical examination would reveal that Victim 2 died from a single gunshot wound to the chest.

In a recorded interview, an identified male would inform police that he was personally familiar with the suspect, who he identified as **CEDRIC CHAPPELL JR**, DOB 7/09/1992 (defendant). Police administered a six person sequential lineup to this male, who positively identified the defendant as the person who shot Victim 1 and Victim 2.

COMPLAINT SUPPLEMENT

The defendant is a student at Valley City State University in North Dakota. Police contacted the defendant to ask him about the incident, and he admitted being present at the scene and hearing gunshots. He also admitted to dressing in a manner consistent with how he was described by Victim 1.

OFFENSE

COUNT 1: MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE (INTENTIONAL) (FELONY)
MINN. STAT. § 609.19, SUBD 1(1); § 609.11
PENALTY: 3-40 YEARS

That on or about September 28, 2013, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, **CEDRIC CHAPPELL JR**, while using a firearm, caused the death of Victim 2, a human being, with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation.

COUNT 2: ATTEMPTED MURDER IN THE SECOND DEGREE (INTENTIONAL) (FELONY)
MINN. STAT. § 609.19, SUBD 1(1); § 609.11; § 609.17
PENALTY: 3-20 YEARS

That on or about September 28, 2013, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, **CEDRIC CHAPPELL JR**, while using a firearm, attempted to cause the death of Victim 1, a human being, with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation.

NOTICE: You must appear for every court hearing on this charge. A failure to appear for court on this charge is a criminal offense and may be punished as provided in Minn. Stat. § 609.49.
