**COMPLAINT**

The Complainant, being duly sworn, makes complaint to the above-named Court and states that there is probable cause to believe that the Defendant committed the following offense(s). The complainant states that the following facts establish PROBABLE CAUSE:

Complainant, Christopher Millard, of the Eden Prairie Police Department, has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On August 1, 2013, at approximately 7:46 p.m., Eden Prairie Police, Fire Rescue and Hennepin County paramedics all responded to the area of Eden Prairie Road and Kurtz Lane, Eden Prairie, Hennepin County, Minnesota pursuant to a report of a single vehicle crash. Upon arrival, officers observed that a silver Chevrolet Corvette convertible, bearing MN Lic. No. 710 JTL, had knocked over a power line pole and flipped over. Two adult males were located outside the vehicle. The first, who was located near the driver's side of the vehicle, was later identified as **RANDOLL GUY SLOAN**, Defendant herein. Officers and medical personnel noted the odor of alcohol coming from the Defendant's person. The second adult male was located closest to the passenger side and was later identified as Victim. He was determined to be deceased at approximately 9:24 p.m., after his arrival at Hennepin County Medical Center (HCMC).

Defendant was also transported to HCMC where he was treated for a broken leg and a significant laceration on his head, among other injuries. A warrant was obtained for a blood draw and Defendant's blood was drawn at 11:35 p.m. When asked about the crash by law enforcement, Defendant said he had no memory of the incident.

Officers spoke with a witness who reported that he had been traveling southbound on Eden Prairie Road when the Corvette passed him at a high rate of speed. He noticed that a person in the Corvette gave him the finger. He continued southbound on Eden Prairie Road and noticed a cloud of dust. He then saw the same Corvette upside

down and two guys lying on the ground. Another witness reported estimating that the Corvette was going at least double the speed limit.

Your Complainant received the case for investigation and made contact with two additional witnesses who reported seeing Defendant and Victim leaving the Gold Nugget Tavern and Grille, located in Minnetonka a short time prior to the crash. One of the witnesses, Witness A stated that both men looked "a little off" and their faces were red. She further stated that it appeared that they were intoxicated. Witness A stated that one of the men was heavier set and the other was a thinner build. Both witnesses were shown two photo lineups – one containing the Defendant's photo and the other containing the Victim's photo. Both witnesses identified the Defendant as the person they observed get into the driver's seat of the Corvette. Neither witness was able to identify the passenger.

Your Complainant obtained search warrants for a buccal swab for the Defendant, as well as for the vehicle, which had been towed to a secure garage in Eden Prairie. Hennepin County Crime Lab personnel processed the vehicle and obtained swabbings of blood like substance from both deployed airbags, along the frame for the windshield on the driver's side and along the right rear of the vehicle and driver's side mirror. Your Complainant confirmed that the vehicle was registered to the Defendant.

On August 16, 2013, your Complainant received a report from the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension indicating that Defendant's blood alcohol content was .19.

On October 4, 2013, your Complainant received a report from the Hennepin County Crime Lab indicating that Defendant's DNA was found in the swabbings taken from both airbags as well as the windshield of the vehicle. Victim's was not. On November 18<sup>th</sup>, the Crime Lab released a second report indicating that Defendant's DNA was found in other swabbings taken from the vehicle and Victim's was not.

On November 5, 2013, the Minnesota State Patrol released their accident reconstruction report. While unable to make reliable speed calculations for the collision, the reconstructionist opined that the amount of vehicle damage as well as the severity of the injuries was consistent with the vehicle traveling substantially over the posted speed limit of 45 mph. It was also determined that as the Defendant approached the curve in the roadway, he was unable to maintain control of the vehicle, due to the high rate of speed. The vehicle then left the roadway, struck the power line pole, some signs and a curb and then rolled, causing both Defendant and Victim to be ejected from the vehicle.

Defendant is not in custody.

### **OFFENSE**

COUNT 1: CRIMINAL VEHICULAR HOMICIDE (FELONY)  
MINN. STAT. § 609.21, SUBDS. 1(2) (i), 1a(a)  
PENALTY: 0-10 YEARS AND/OR \$20,000

That on or about August 1, 2013, Eden Prairie, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, **RANDOLL GUY SLOAN** did, by operating a vehicle in a negligent manner while under the influence of alcohol, cause the death of Victim .


COUNT 2: CRIMINAL VEHICULAR HOMICIDE (FELONY)  
 MINN. STAT. § 609.21, SUBDS. 1(3), 1a(a)  
 PENALTY: 0-10 YEARS AND/OR \$20,000

That on or about August 1, 2013, Eden Prairie, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, **RANDOLL GUY SLOAN** did, by operating a vehicle while having an alcohol concentration of .08 or more, cause the death of Victim.

COUNT 3: CRIMINAL VEHICULAR HOMICIDE (FELONY)  
 MINN. STAT. § 609.21, SUBDS. 1(1), 1a(a)  
 PENALTY: 0-10 YEARS AND/OR \$20,000

That on or about August 1, 2013, Eden Prairie, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, **RANDOLL GUY SLOAN** did, by operating a vehicle in a grossly negligent manner, cause the death of Victim.

**NOTICE: You must appear for every court hearing on this charge. A failure to appear for court on this charge is a criminal offense and may be punished as provided in Minn. Stat. § 609.49.**
