The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.222.1, 609.11.5(a), 609.101.2

Maximum Sentence: 7 YEARS AND/OR \$4,200-\$14,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 04/30/2014

Charge Description: That on or about April 30, 2014, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, KIBBIE SHAKEEL AKBARK WALKER, assaulted Victim A while using a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On April 30, 2014 at 12:55 PM, officers responded to a report of a shooting near Hennepin County Medical Center in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. Officers spoke to numerous witnesses who reported that a black male wearing a grey sweatshirt fired multiple shots from a silver handgun at an occupied black Chevy Impala and then ran from the scene. Witnesses reported that the gunman's arm was straight when he was aiming and firing at the vehicle. Officers were informed that the Impala also fled the area. Witnesses reported that, as the gunman fled, he removed his grey sweatshirt and threw a handgun on the ground. Other witnesses reported seeing the gunman flee into a store located at 1431 11th Ave. S. Officers entered the store and located the only individual inside the store who matched the suspect's description, an adult male identified as KIBBIE SHAKEEL AKBARK WALKER, the Defendant in this case. Officers observed that Defendant was excited and nervous. The store clerk reported that Defendant just entered the store and asked to use the phone. Officers observed that Defendant was not wearing a jacket or sweatshirt despite the fact that it was 37 degrees outside. Defendant was arrested.

Officers located the handgun and sweatshirt that Defendant dropped. Forensic testing revealed that Defendant's fingerprint was located on the handgun. Officers also recognized the sweatshirt as the same sweatshirt that Defendant had worn when officers interviewed him on April 15, 2014 in connection with another shooting.

In a Mirandized statement, Defendant admitted that he was downtown at HCMC, but he denied knowing anything about a shooting. Officers then informed Defendant that his fingerprint was on the recovered firearm. In response, Defendant's demeanor changed, admitted that he "fucked up," and asked how much "time" he would receive.

Officers learned that, shortly after the shooting, an adult female with a gunshot wound had been admitted to Abbott Hospital. Officers spoke to the female, identified as Victim A, who confirmed that she was shot in the leg in this incident. Victim A stated that she was with another adult female, Victim B, and her infant son. Victim A stated that Victim B drove her to HCMC in the black Impala for a medical appointment because Victim A is pregnant. When they were near the intersection of 8th St. and Chicago Avenue, she began to hear gunshots and then she felt pain in her knee. Victim A stated that she was seated in the front passenger seat when she was shot.

Officers located the vehicle, and there were multiple bullet holes in the driver's side, the roof, the back window, and interior of the vehicle. Officers observed blood on the front passenger seat. Officers impounded the vehicle. Further forensic testing is pending.

Records indicate that Defendant is a documented YNT/Taliban gang member and that he was shot by alleged rival gang members on April 19, 2014.

Defendant is in custody.
