COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - With Intent-Not Premeditated

Minnesota Statute: 609.19.1(1), with reference to: 609.11.5(a), 609.17.4(2), 609.19.1

Maximum Sentence: HALF OF, 40 YEARS

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/11/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16001957

Charge Description: That on or about May 11, 2016, in Minnetonka, Hennepin County, Minnesota, EDWARD TYRONE DAVIS, attempted to cause the death of a known adult male, Victim, a human being, with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation, while using a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On May 11, 2016, at about 11:44 p.m., Minnetonka police were dispatched to an apartment building at 9731 Minnetonka Boulevard, Minnetonka, Hennepin County, Minnesota, in response to a report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers found an adult male, Victim herein, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound in his midsection. He was semiconscious and transported immediately for emergency medical treatment. Also present was Victim's girlfriend, a known adult female, Witness 1 herein, who reported the following.

She (Witness 1) was at home with her two-year-old son when she heard pounding on her patio door and found EDWARD TYRONE DAVIS, Defendant herein and father of the child, trying to enter. Witness 1 unlocked the door and Defendant pushed in without Witness 1's consent. The two were arguing when Victim entered the apartment. Defendant saw Victim and immediately pulled a handgun that had been concealed on his person and fired at Victim. Victim picked up the child but then released the child as he ran down the apartment hallway, pursued by Defendant. Witness 1 followed into the hallway and saw Defendant fire his handgun multiple times at Victim, hitting him in the back. Victim collapsed. Defendant fled the scene and officers began to search for him.

Investigators located an address for Defendant and at 12:26 a.m., May 12, 2016, officers observed a man later identified as Defendant get out of a car not known to be associated with Defendant. An officer pursued and stopped the vehicle and interviewed the driver, a known adult male, Witness 2 herein. Witness 2 told officers that his friend Edward (Defendant) had called and asked for a ride because his car had broken down. At Defendant's instruction, Witness 2 picked up Defendant on Highway 169 and drove him to the address at which Defendant was observed. Officers obtained a search warrant and entered the residence where Defendant had been dropped off and arrested him.

Investigators obtained surveillance video from Witness 1's apartment building which shows Defendant chasing Victim down the hallway and running out the main entrance.

Defendant remains in custody.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
