The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - Without Intent - While Committing a Felony

Minnesota Statute: 609.19.2(1), with reference to: 609.19.2(1), 609.11.4

Maximum Sentence: 40 YEARS

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/23/2017

Control #(ICR#): 17448002

Charge Description: That on or about 11/23/2017, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, ANENIA MARIE HARE, did without intent to effect the death of any person, cause the death of E.C., a human being, while committing or attempting to commit a felony offense while using a dangerous weapon.

Minimum Sentence: 1 YEAR AND 1 DAY

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Your Complainant is an Investigator with the Minneapolis Police Department, and in that capacity has investigated the facts and circumstances of the offense alleged herein, including reviewing the reports of other officers. Your Complainant believes the following establishes probable cause:

On November 23, 2017, officers were dispatched to 5761 33rd Avenue South, Apartment 6, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, the residence of ANENIA MARIE HARE, Defendant herein, after receiving four 911 calls placed by Defendant. Responding officers located an elderly man face down in the living room, near a broken window and other signs of an apparent struggle. The man, identified as 69 year-old E.C., Victim herein, was transported for medical attention but was pronounced dead at the hospital.

In a post-Miranda statement, Defendant stated that she had invited Victim over for Thanksgiving dinner, but before they started to eat, she looked over and saw Victim lighting up a crack pipe, which made Defendant angry because Victim did not ask permission to smoke crack and did not offer to share. Defendant stated that she stood in front of the apartment in an attempt to be dominating, with a television antennae in one hand and butcher knife in the other hand, and told Victim that she would not let him leave.

Defendant stated that Victim yelled for neighbors to call 911 as Defendant stood in front of the door preventing his exit, and then Victim grabbed a vacuum cleaner and broke the window out with it. When Victim broke out the window, Defendant stated that she grabbed him around the shoulders and fell on top of him, at which time they struggled as Victim tried to get the knife out of Defendant's hand. Defendant stated that after she was on top of Victim, who was face down for a while, he started snoring.

A review of 911 calls placed by Defendant regarding the Victim, unconscious in her apartment, include Defendant stating, "I put his ass to sleep." Defendant also told responding officers, "I just grabbed him by the front of his chest and he went down. To me I just felt like I put him in a sleeper hold or something."

In the autopsy report, Victim's cause of death was homicidal violence.

In Minnesota, both false imprisonment and assault in the second degree are felonies.

Defendant is in custody.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
