COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Possess Ammo/Any Firearm - Conviction or Adjudicated Delinquent for Crime of Violence

Minnesota Statute: 624.713.1(2), with reference to: 609.11.5(b), 624.713.2(b), 609.11.9

Maximum Sentence: 15 YEARS AND/OR \$30,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/20/2017

Control #(ICR#): 17315451

Charge Description: That on or about August 20, 2017, in the City of Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, TRAVION JACOA JONES possessed ammunition or a firearm and he has been convicted or adjudicated delinquent in this state or elsewhere of a crime of violence, Controlled Substance Crime in the 4th Degree ? Possession with Intent to Sell from December 2006.

Minimum Sentence: 5 YEARS

Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon

Charge Description: That on or about August 20, 2017, in the City of Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, TRAVION JACOA JONES assaulted Victim 3 with a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On August 20, 2017, just before 2:00 a.m., officers responded to a shooting in the parking of a club in downtown Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. The shooter ran from the scene but was chased by police and security. Police were able to apprehend the shooter, who was identified as TRAVION JACOA JONES [(D.O.B. 4/30/1989); ("Jones")]. One of the officers heard metal hit the ground as he was chasing Jones and believed the item to be the firearm. A firearm was recovered in that area.

An adult female ("Victim 1") had been shot in the foot. An adult male ("Victim 2") had been shot in his wrist and scrotum. Both were treated at the hospital. A security guard ("Victim 3") discovered he had a bullet hole (one in the front and one in the back) of the left armpit of his shirt.

Police learned there was an altercation where Jones shoved Victim 2. Jones was told to leave and was subsequently maced by Victim 3. Jones pulled out a firearm, shot at Victim 3 once, and then shot several rounds into a crowd of people, which apparently struck Victim 1 and Victim 2. Jones was then chased by security and police until he was apprehended.

Jones has a juvenile adjudication for felony Controlled Substance Crime in the 4th Degree – Possession with Intent to Sell from December 2006 (D.C. File No. 62-J8-06-556067).

BLAKELY NOTICE: Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 244.10, the Minnesota Sentencing Guidelines, and pertinent case law including State v. Fleming, 883 N.W.2d 790, 794-96 (Minn. 2016). The grounds for departure are (1) the offense was committed in a particularly serious way and (2) the defendant's conduct represented a greater than normal danger to the safety of other people.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
