The Juvenile Court has jurisdiction by reason of the following allegations: The above-named juvenile is alleged to be delinquent pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 260B.007, Subd. 6(1) because said child has violated a state/local law as follows:

Count 1: A3203 Assault-3rd Degree-Substantial Bodily Harm (Felony) (Aid/Abet)
MINN. STAT. 609.223.1, 609.223.1, 609.05.1, 609.05.2, 609.101.2

That on or about 8/6/2020, near Park Avenue and 82nd Street East, in Bloomington, Hennepin County, Minnesota, Aidan Reyes-Montalvo acting alone or intentionally aiding, advising, hiring, counseling or conspiring with another or otherwise procures the other to commit the crime, assaulted M.M.S. and inflicted substantial bodily harm.

PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT

Your Petitioner is an Assistant County Attorney. In that capacity, Petitioner believes the facts and circumstances recited below establish probable cause:

On or about August 6, 2020, around 10:10 p.m., Bloomington Police responded to a reported assault that took place near Park Avenue and 82nd Street East, in Bloomington, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Police arrived at Dar Al Farooq mosque located at 8201 Park Avenue South and spoke with M.M.S. ("Victim" herein). Victim was holding his left shoulder and said he could not move it. An ambulance was called to treat Victim. Victim told police that as he walked from his home to the mosque he was attacked by two males near the crosswalk at Park Avenue and 82nd Street East, just outside the mosque. Victim did not know the attackers. He described them as males in their teens to 20s, one white and one black. Victim allowed that the "white male" could also have been of Hispanic descent. The lighter skinned male was more physically aggressive, but both males struck or kicked Victim. The lighter skinned male tried to pull Victim to the ground by his shoulder and arm. Victim attempted to push the attackers away to defend himself. Nothing was taken from Victim. Victim later learned he had two fractures in his left shoulder and he had to keep his arm in a sling. Police also observed Victim's right eye was red the day after the attack.

Police spoke with witnesses and reviewed video to identify the attackers. A witness, S.S. saw two juvenile males, one white and one black walk into the mosque parking lot from Smith Park just prior to the assault.

Video from the school attached to the mosque also showed two juveniles, one lighter skinned and one darker skinned in Smith Park, approach Victim, and then run back to Smith Park.

Police spoke with other juveniles present in the park. One juvenile, A.M.P. told police that "Chris" who is Black, and "Aidan" who is Hispanic had talked about robbing someone because they needed cash. A.M.P. also told police where the suspects lived. Police later identified C.K.C. ("Co-Respondent" herein) (DOB: 11/02/2006) and Aidan Reyes-Montalvo ("Respondent" herein) (DOB: 10/26/2003) as being involved in the assault.

Co-Respondent was arrested and interviewed by police. In a post-Miranda statement, Co-Respondent said he did not hit a man at the park, but admitted that he "shook him up" and maybe pushed him. Co-Respondent said that it was "dumb fun."

Respondent is currently in custody in the Juvenile Detention Center.
