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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - With Intent-Not Premeditated**

Minnesota Statute: 609.19.1(1), with reference to: 609.11.4, 609.19.1

Maximum Sentence: 40 YEARS

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 01/29/2017

Control #(ICR#): 17033947

Charge Description: That on or about 1/29/2017, in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, RONDELL RUSSELL CAMP caused the death of Victim A, a human being, with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation, while using a dangerous weapon.

Minimum Sentence: 1 YEAR AND 1 DAY

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On January 29, 2017, police and emergency responders assisted an injured male in the alley of the 3700 Block of Aldrich Avenue North in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. The male was identified as RONDELL RUSSELL CAMP, the Defendant. Witnesses first observed the Defendant crawling through the alley. He was screaming and in great pain. The Defendant told witnesses there was a dead body in a nearby garage. A witness investigated and found an adult male lying on the floor of a garage at 3742 Aldrich Avenue North. The witness directed police to the garage.

Police found the male, identified in this complaint as Victim A, lying on his back on the floor of the garage next to a car. Police and emergency responders quickly determined Victim A was dead on arrival, but had died recently. Victim A had sustained numerous lacerations to his head. Victim A also sustained numerous facial bone fractures. Responders located a large stab wound to the left side of Victim A's neck beneath his ear. Victim A also exhibited numerous defensive wounds to both hands. Victim A lay in a large pool of blood beneath his head. A box wrench was found beneath Victim A's shoulder. Blood was spattered on the car and other surfaces near where he lay. Blood also appeared to have been transferred to the hood of the car.

Police learned that Victim A often repaired cars in the garage. Witnesses told police they overheard a loud verbal argument from inside the garage. The next thing witnesses heard was the Defendant screaming in pain in the alley.

Police rode with the Defendant to the hospital for treatment to his leg. The Defendant's hands, face and clothing were spattered with blood. The Defendant had no apparent injuries consistent with the considerable amount of blood on his hands, face and clothing. The Defendant claimed he drove to Victim A's location. Police learned the car in the garage next to Victim A was owned by the Defendant. The Defendant told family members upon entering the hospital that he was going to jail.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
