NARRATIVE

On 09/07/2019 I Trooper j. Armstrong SP312 was on patrol in the 2400 East Metro District of the Minnesota State Patrol. I was operating my fully marked squad car and assigned to the afternoon shift. At approximately 2254 hours I was assigned to assist Richfield Police Department with crowd control after an officer involved shooting incident.

I arrived on scene at approximately 2321 hours. I parked near the 77th Street and Chicago Avenue intersection. I stood on the south sidewalk near the apartment building to form a line between the growing crowd and the scene. After approximately an hour I observed a group forming on the west side in the middle of 77th Street. I informed the Bloomington Police Sergeant who was directing the crowd control officers of my observation. He instructed me to gather two additional Troopers and to fill the gap on the west end of the scene. I asked Trooper J. Lanoue SP106, and Trooper N. Folger SP98 to assist me. We took our position on the west end of the scene nearest the 77th and Chicago Avenue intersection for the remainder of the time on scene.

I cleared the scene at approximately 0221 hours.

NARRATIVE

On 9/7/2019, I Trooper Cariveau SP91 was working the Minnesota State Patrol's West Metro 4550 station. I was driving a fully marked state-issued squad car #46104. The weather was cloudy, and it was lightly raining off and on.

At approximately 2254 hours, I was dispatched to a request for help from Edina/Bloomington Police Departments regarding an incident they had. I was notified by dispatch that there was an officer-involved shooting that gathered the attention of many bystanders. I responded from my location of 394 and Dunwoody Blvd, and arrived at approximately 2303 hours.

While on scene, I assisted with crowd control. I stood on line with multiple other Troopers and local officers. I stood facing a group of people, ranging from 20 to over 50 at times. The group I was monitoring was on the south side of 77th St and east of Chicago Ave.

After the bulk of the crowd dispersed, I was allowed to leave the scene and checked out with Hennepin County Sheriff's Office prior to my departure. I departed at approximately 0227 hours on 9/8/2019.

On 9/7/19 I, Trooper T. Carter SP608 was working the afternoon shift in the downtown Minneapolis D2500 district. I was advised by dispatch of an officer involved shooting in the area of 77th and Chicago in Richfield. Dispatch advised that they were requesting assistance due to large crowds building in the area. I advised that I would respond to assist.

I arrived on scene at approximately 2311 hours.

Responding State Patrol units were directed to maintain crowd control while the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office processed the scene. I was positioned on the eastbound side of 77th, on the south sidewalk, facing south. We maintained the position between Chicago Ave (west limit) and 12th Ave S (east limit.)

NARRATIVE

On the evening of September 07, 2019, I was working an overtime bus detail in Minneapolis, MN. A little before 2307 hours, I was nearing the end of a motorcoach (bus) inspection on 3rd Avenue South and 2nd Street South in the city of Minneapolis. During that time I overheard a law enforcement officer requested - in a firm and slightly excited voice - additional officers at 77th Street and Chicago Ave in the city of Richfield on L-Tac 1 for crowd control. Within a short period of time after the initial request, multiple agencies were requested to respond to an officer involved shooting at the previously noted location. Clearing my motorcoach inspection I responded to the shooting location at 2307 hours, arriving at the intersection from the west of Chicago Ave on 77th St. at 2319 hours.

I walked expediently to the intersection, then just to the east of the intersection where two larger apartment complexes with a large group of people are present along 77th St. My assigned task was to provide crowd control along a tape-off area outlined by yellow police tape. During that time, the crowd was visibly and verbally upset with a couple of key people acting in a fashion that caused other onlookers to become more agitated. One was a middle-aged black male approximately 6 feet to 6 feet 2 inches tall with a medium to large build, and the other was an older white male. The male had a bald head, a plaid-like shirt with dark colored pants and pink or salmon colored tennis shoes. The older white male was approximately 5 feet 5 inches to 5 feet 10 inches with a large build. He had a goatee with dark hair with noticeable grey throughout. Additionally his hair was tied in a pony tail that extended about 1/4 to 1/2 way down his back. He was wearing a black jacket, baseball cap, glasses, and dark colored pants/jeans. There was approximately 40-50 onlookers within the area of where the shooting took place. The black male stated how the stop and shooting were on Facebook which excited the crowd, and kept repeating in a loud, yelling tone that you don't shoot an unarmed man. The white male kept repeating where he was walking to and helping others so he nor others were shot by police.

Towards the end of my time standing post in front of one of the apartment complexes, I overheard a female voice talking with some individuals. I was not able to see her as vehicles parked in the apartment complex parking lot was blocking my view. While she spoke in a loud voice, I overheard her state they were lying, and he had a knife either on him or in his hands. She repeated this one or two more times before she stopped speaking.

At 0234 hours I was advised that I could clear the scene.

NARRATIVE

On 09/07-08/2019, I, Trooper James Lanoue was working a 1500-0100 shift in the Minnesota State Patrol 4450 station.

On 09/07/2019, State Patrol dispatch aired a call of an Assist Other Agency for the City of Richfield for an officer involved shooting located in the area of 77th Street and Chicago Avenue in the City of Richfield. The call stated that they were requesting additional officers to the scene as a large crowd of people were gathering at the scene. The request was for scene security.

At the time of the call, I was on another Assist to Bloomington Police Department for a vehicle that they had stopped on westbound MNTH 62 at Portland that was reported as stolen. After I cleared that call, I went enroute to this call. I arrived on scene at 2324 hours. I parked at the intersection of 77th Street and Chicago Avenue. I walked to the perimeter and checked in with an Edina Police Officer who was running the personnel log at that time. He assigned me to the perimeter on the south side of the scene. At this location, there was a group of people standing there and a few were being vocal. I stood at the south side of the perimeter to assist with scene security.

I was later assigned to the west side of the perimeter on 77th Street just east of Chicago Avenue because there was a group of bystanders assembling. This group of bystanders was peaceful. I remained at this position along the perimeter until I was informed that I could leave. I left the scene at 0221 hours. I was signed out by a Hennepin county deputy who was assigned to maintain the scene personnel log.

NARRATIVE

On September 7th, 2019, I Lieutenant Lee #2406 was working my assigned shift of 2030-0630 to the east metro district.

At approximately 2255 hours, I was made aware via radio that there was an assist other agency call for more squads in the area of 77th Street and Chicago Avenue in Richfield. I had also learned there was an officer involved shooting at this location and squads were needed for crowd control. I advised dispatch I was aware of the call in progress and requested flight for surveillance of the crowd.

I arrived on scene at approximately 2345 hours and parked my squad in the intersection of 12th Avenue South and 77th Street, facing southbound and blocking the westbound traffic. I saw multiple other squads in this area and crime scene tape preventing traffic to enter westbound. I exited my squad car and walked toward the scene where the other officers were standing on line.

I approached the crime scene and saw multiple squad cars with their emergency lights on and a passenger vehicle that were eastbound on 77th Avenue in the left lane. I could also see the silhouette of a person laying down in the grassy median area with a white sheet covering them. This area is a two way roadway with two lanes in both directions (east and west), with a raised grassy and curbed median separating the two directions. The suspect vehicle and squad cars were parked east of Chicago Avenue.

I crossed the secondary perimeter crime scene tape to meet with some troopers who were standing on line. I was met by a Bloomington Police Department sergeant who briefed me on the current situation. The smaller crowd that was directly in front of us (near the west end of the secondary perimeter) was quiet and was standing on the grass. The larger group that was on the south end of the perimeter had approximately 40 people, with a few people yelling loudly at the officers on line.

I met with several troopers on scene and ensured they did not need relief from their current positions. The group of troopers I met with were on the eastbound lanes of 77th Avenue near the south sidewalk, facing southbound. The group of people we were providing crowd control over were south of the line of troopers, facing north. As time passed, I dismissed troopers from the scene as the crowd was getting smaller.

I spoke to the Bloomington sergeant multiple times throughout my time on scene. At one point he advised me the mapping equipment that was being used by Hennepin County's Crime Scene Investigations unit was working slowly, but after that the medical examiner would remove the body from the scene. At approximately 0420 hours, the suspect's body was removed from the scene by the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office. I cleared the scene at approximately 0437 hours.

I also met a Hennepin County Sheriff's Office detective, Detective C. Nybeck. Detective Nybeck requested me to send him a list of the troopers on scene so he could conduct a question and answer session at a later date and time.

NARRATIVE

On Saturday September 7th, 2019, at approximately 2254 hours, I Trooper Moren #141 was working a regular scheduled shift in District 2500. A call was dispatched asking for assistance with crowd control following an officer-involved shooting near the intersection of 77th St E and Chicago Ave S in Richfield. The call was to assist Edina Police, Richfield Police, and Bloomington Police.

I answered for the call and arrived on-scene at 2301 hours. I parked and secured my squad car within the outer perimeter and proceeded into the inner perimeter. I stood at the perimeter assisting with crowd control on the sidewalk on the south-side of the scene facing an apartment complex. I initially estimated about 30 people in the crowd. At one point we moved the crowd further back and established a larger perimeter with a buffer zone of approximately 20 feet between where we were standing and where the crowd was. I told a few individuals in the crowd to move back but did not use any physical force. Later I estimated 40-50 people gathered in front of us. At no point did the crowd get physical, from what I could see, it was only verbal. Throughout the incident I did not communicate or talk with anyone in the crowd, other than to tell people to get back when moving the perimeter back. I was told I could leave by Lt. Lee, who was on scene, and cleared at 0357 hours.

I drove with my emergency lights and siren activated from Golden Valley and arrived at approximately 2304 hours. I parked my squad outside of the crime scene tape on the west end of the scene. I then assisted with crowd control on the south side of the scene until I cleared at approximately 0246 hours.

NARRATIVE
