The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-3rd Degree-Substantial Bodily Harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.223.1, with reference to: 609.223.1, 609.101.2

Maximum Sentence: 5 YEARS AND/OR \$3,000-\$10,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/24/2014

Control #(ICR#): 14414315

Charge Description: That on or about November 24, 2014, in the City of Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, DAQUEIN DOMINIQUE MCNEIL assaulted another and inflicted substantial bodily harm.

COUNT II

Charge: Domestic Assault - By Strangulation

Minnesota Statute: 609.2247.2, with reference to: 609.2247.2

Maximum Sentence: 3 YEARS AND/OR \$5,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/24/2014

Control #(ICR#): 14414315

Charge Description: That on or about November 24, 2014, in the City of Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, DAQUEIN DOMINIQUE MCNEIL assaulted a family or household member by intentionally impeding normal breathing or circulation of the blood by applying pressure on the throat or neck or by blocking the nose or mouth of another person.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On November 24, 2014, around 11:38 a.m., officers from the Minneapolis Police Department were dispatched to a domestic assault that occurred in an apartment on the 900 block of Fulton Street Southeast, in the City of Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. Upon arrival, officers met with an adult female ("Victim"), who was visibly upset, distraught, and shaking.

Officers learned the following information. Victim had been dating DAQUEIN DOMINIQUE MCNEIL [(D.O.B. 11/28/1993); ("Defendant")] for approximately 10 months. They live in separate places. That morning, Defendant came over to pick up his backpack, which he needed because he was going out of town for a basketball game. Victim was sleeping in her bedroom when Defendant came in with a cooking pan in his hand. Defendant used the pan to smash a mirror, and then he started pulling out dresser drawers. Defendant dumped a bottle of alcohol all over Victim's clothes and other items. Defendant was yelling at Victim and saying that she is ruining his life. At some point, Defendant took Victim's phone. Victim's roommate heard the commotion and came into the room to try to get Defendant to calm down. The roommate got Defendant to leave, and then the roommate left after he thought the situation was under control.

Shortly thereafter, Defendant came back into the apartment and dragged Victim off of the bed by her ankles. Defendant stripped off Victim's pants and dumped a jug of cold water from the refrigerator all over Victim. Defendant kept retrieving cold water from the kitchen to dump on Victim. Defendant then pushed Victim up against the wall and used both of his hands to strangle her. Victim was gasping for air and was begging Defendant to stop. Defendant told Victim as he strangled her, "you ruined my life, now I am going to ruin your life." Defendant released his grip and Victim went into the bathroom. Victim was cold from the water and took a shower to try and warm up. Defendant kept dumping cold water on Victim as she showered. Defendant took a wet dish towel and began snapping it against Victim's skin. Defendant ripped off the shower curtain and Victim got on the floor. Defendant started whipping Victim with his leather belt repeatedly. Victim was still unclothed at the time. Victim was crying and screaming, so Defendant took the wet dish towel and placed it over Victim's mouth. Defendant continued whipping Victim and kept saying how much he hated her. Victim was eventually able to get out of the apartment and ran to a neighbor for help.

Victim had large welts and marks all over her body, and she was bleeding from a cut on her wrist. Victim also had a reddish mark on her neck where Defendant strangled her.

Victim thought Defendant was still in her apartment, but Defendant had already fled the scene by the time police arrived. Officers photographed the damage in the apartment and found the wet rag and belt that Victim described. Victim noticed that in addition to her phone, Defendant had also taken her iPad, computer, keys to her car, and her actual car.

Officers were able to later locate and arrest Defendant, who still had Victim's phone on him. Victim also found her car parked outside of Defendant's residence.

Photographs of the victim's injuries the following day depict bruising and marks all over her body. She has multiple large and prominent bruises on her arms, back, buttocks, chest, and legs. Her legs are covered with large dark bruises. Her right knee and shin also have several long red lash marks.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS
