COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.222.1, 609.101.2

Maximum Sentence: 7 YEARS AND/OR \$4,200-\$14,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 04/16/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15006545

Charge Description: That on or about April 16, 2015 in Robbinsdale, Hennepin County, Minnesota, TANIA MARNIQUE HARRIS, assaulted a known adult female, while armed with a dangerous weapon.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On April 16, 2015 at about 5:55 p.m., Robbinsdale police officers were dispatched to an apartment building at 3755 Hubbard Avenue North, Robbinsdale, Hennepin County, Minnesota, in response to a report of a fight involving at least two women. Upon arrival, officers spoke to persons outside the building.

In later investigation, officers determined that two young women, one of them TANIA MARNIQUE HARRIS, Defendant herein, and the other a known adult female, Victim herein, had been arguing for at least a day.

On April 16, Victim and acquaintances came to the subject address. Victim was at the front door of the apartment building talking with Defendant's mother while Victim's acquaintances remained in a car at the curb. When officers arrived, one of them spoke to the occupants of the car and another was at the front door.

Without warning, Defendant burst through the apartment building front door, chasing Victim at full run. Victim saw Defendant coming and was several yards in front of Defendant. As Victim came through the front door, witnesses saw a large knife in Defendant's right hand. One witness reported hearing Defendant scream: "I'm going to kill you bitch!" As Victim ran to get behind the officer standing by the car, two additional witnesses saw the knife in Defendant's hand. The officer by the car had drawn his service pistol and ordered Defendant to stop and drop the knife; this command was overheard by nearby witnesses.

Defendant did not slow her pursuit nor drop the weapon. The officer by the car fired twice, injuring Defendant. Near where Defendant fell, officers recovered a large kitchen knife. Defendant was taken for medical treatment under arrest.

At the hospital, two witnesses heard Defendant state that she was shot because she was chasing someone with a knife and that she was chasing someone because she was angry.

Defendant remains in custody.
