COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Possess Ammo/Any Firearm - Conviction or Adjudicated Delinquent for Crime of Violence

Minnesota Statute: 624.713.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 15 YEARS IN PRISON AND A \$30,000 FINE

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/08/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15013580

Charge Description: That on or about August 8, 2015, in the City of Edina, Hennepin County, Minnesota COLIN PETER REINSMOEN possessed a firearm after having been convicted of a crime of violence.

Minimum Sentence: 5 YEARS

COUNT II

Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.222.1, 609.11.5(a), 609.101.2

Maximum Sentence: 7 YEARS AND/OR \$4,200-\$14,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/08/2015

Control #(ICR#): 15013580

Charge Description: That on or about August 8, 2015, in the City of Edina, Hennepin County, Minnesota, COLIN PETER REINSMOEN assaulted another with a dangerous weapon.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On August 8, 2015, officers responded to an apartment in the City of Edina, Hennepin County, Minnesota, for a welfare check. The subject of the welfare check was identified as COLIN PETER REINSMOEN [(D.O.B. 11/12/1979); ("Defendant")]. Defendant has mental health issues and started threatening his parents when they confronted him about getting help. Defendant told his mother he could "take her down" and called his father a "pussy." Defendant also told his father, "I could lay you out." Defendant's parents called 911.

After the confrontation with his parents, but before police arrived, Defendant went back to the couch and covered himself with a blanket. When the police arrived, his parents told him that there were people there to help him. Defendant stood up with one of his hands in a clutched position covered by the blanket. An officer asked Defendant if they could see what was under the blanket. Defendant refused. Eventually, Defendant threw the blanket aside and raised his hand, holding a handgun. He pointed the weapon directly at an officer. Two officers fired and struck Defendant.

Defendant was taken into custody and officers recovered the firearm, which was a black semi-automatic BB gun.

Defendant was transported to the hospital and needed surgery, but he is expected to fully recover.

Defendant has a lengthy criminal history including felony Controlled Substance Crime in the Fifth Degree from May 6, 20015 in Carver County (10-KO-02-000969) and from February 1, 2011 in Dakota County (D.C. File No. 19HA-CR-10-328), Simple Robbery from March 17, 2005 (D.C. File No. 27-CR-04-078976), and a felony Violation of a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order from May 16, 2012 (D.C. File No. 27-CR-12-9540).
