The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon-Substantial Bodily Harm**

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.2, with reference to: 609.222.2, 609.11.5(a), 609.101.2

Maximum Sentence: 10 YEARS AND/OR \$6,000-\$20,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/09/2016

Control #(ICR#): 16289988

Charge Description: That on or about 8/9/2016, in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, MARQUISE TREVONE HAMMONDS-FORD, assaulted a juvenile female and inflicted substantial bodily harm, while possessing a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

Charge Description: That on or about 8/18/2016, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, MARQUISE TREVONE HAMMONDS-FORD, born 09/06/1995, with intent to obstruct justice, gave a false name, and false date of birth to a peace officer, when that officer made inquiries incident to a lawful investigatory stop or lawful arrest, or inquiries incident to executing any other duty imposed by law.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On August 9, 2016 at approximately 1634 hours, Minneapolis Police were dispatched to the vicinity of 4100 Dupont Ave N in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, on a report of a shooting. Remarks indicated that a suspicious dark colored SUV believed to be a Ford Explorer had driven to the area and exited the vehicle firing several shots toward a group of people in front of 4100 Dupont Ave N.

When officers arrived, they could see numerous people scattering as though they were scared. Officers approached the individuals who were standing in front of 4100 Dupont Ave N and asked what happened. The witnesses indicated that they were all in front of the residence at 4100 Dupont Ave N when they noticed a suspicious dark colored SUV believed to be a Ford Explorer driving very slowly northbound on Dupont Ave N from 39th Ave N and stopped at the stop sign. The vehicle stayed at the stop sign for approximately 30 seconds, before the driver exited the vehicle with a black handgun and fired several times at a group of people who were in front of 4100 Dupont Ave N, striking a 13 year old girl. The shooter then got back into his car and fled. There were at least 7 individuals standing in front of the house when the shots were fired.

The witnesses identified the shooter as a black male, 20-23 years old with longer dreadlocks or braids. The juvenile victim was transported to North Memorial Medical Center where she was diagnosed with a gunshot wound to her left bicep.

As officers were walking around the area looking for evidence, they observed numerous discharged cartridge casings (DCCs) at the intersection of 41st Ave N and Colfax Ave N. as well as outside of the house located at 4100 Dupont Ave N. Officers also observed several bullet strikes on the exterior of the house. Based on this information, officers believed that two people were shooting at each other, one from the intersection at Colfax and one from in front of the house.

Officers searched the residence located at 4100 Dupont Ave N and discovered two adult males hiding in the back bedroom. These individuals were identified as known gang members M.W. & W.G-M. While speaking with M.W., he indicated that he had been shot at by a rival gang member and was only returning fire to protect his family. M.W. identified the shooter as going by the street name "Tank." The shooter was positively identified as MARQUISE TREVONE HAMMONDS-FORD, DOB: 9/6/95, the Defendant herein. M.W. then showed police where he had hid the gun he fired and escorted officers back to a closet in the back bedroom where officers recovered two handguns. The handguns were identified as a Taurus Ultra Light .38 Caliber 5 shot revolver serial # SF37475 and a Ruger P95DC 9mm semi-automatic pistol serial # 31547728. Both of the serial numbers were run and came back as confirmed stolen guns. M.W. also verified that the several DCCs located in front of the house were from the gun he had fired.

Officers went to North Memorial Medical Center and met with the juvenile female victim. She described the shooter as a black male with light complexion with dreads wearing a white shirt and blue jeans. She indicated that the gun he fired was black. She believed she would be able to identify him if she saw him again. Officers showed the juvenile female a sequential photographic line-up containing the Defendant's photograph and she positively identified the Defendant as the individual who got out of the dark colored SUV and fired a black gun toward them.

Officers spoke with the juvenile female's mother J.G. who stated that they had just returned home and observed a black vehicle sitting at the corner of 41st Ave N and Dupont Ave N. J.G. stated the vehicle was

facing east bound on 41st Ave N and she told everyone outside she thought the vehicle was going to shoot. Immediately after she had alerted the people standing outside, the Defendant got out of the vehicle and began shooting in the direction of 4100 Dupont Ave N, which is her residence. J.G. indicated that at least 7 individuals were standing outside the residence and once the shooting started, everyone started to run and hit the ground. She believed that there were at least 4-5 shots. J.G. saw her daughter fall to the ground and yell, "I'm shot!" After the shooting stopped, everyone ran to her daughter to render aid. Her daughter was screaming and in a great deal of pain so they transported her to North Memorial Medical Center with their own car.

Officers spoke with M.W. who admitted that the gun recovered in the house at 4100 Dupont Ave N was his and he used it to shoot back at the Defendant after the Defendant had shot at him and his family. M.W. admitted that he was a gang member with "Nehimia World 1610" which is considered a "low end" gang in North Minneapolis. Tattooed on his hands were "16" and "10". He admitted that his gang feuds with Northside gangs in the "highs" which is gangs with the territory north of Golden Valley Road. M.W. stated that he was outside with W.G-M., his auntie, her boyfriend, and some kids. He stated that when the vehicle drove past them, it came to a stop and the Defendant started shooting at them. M.W. then pulled his handgun out of his waistband and started returning fire. He thought he shot at the Defendant around four times. M.W. admitted that the 9mm handgun recovered from the house was his and he bought it on the street and knew it was stolen. M.W. said that he knew it was stolen but he needed a gun because he "gang bangs." M.W. then stated that the individual who shot at him was the Defendant who goes by the street name "Tank." The Defendant is a YNT gang member that he had known for a couple of years. M.W. stated that he had gotten into a fight with the Defendant at "tater days" in Brooklyn Center previously. M.W. stated that the Defendant's Facebook account is "Drose Gangmember". Officers went to the page and confirmed it was the Defendant. Officers showed M.W. a photograph and he positively identified the photo as "Tank" and the same individual who shot at him.

Officers spoke with W.G-M. who stated that when he arrived the dark colored SUV vehicle drove by and M.W. said to him, "Them goes those niggas." He saw the vehicle stopped and a black male with dreads got out of the driver's seat and started firing at them. He saw his sister get hit and go to the ground. W.G-M. started collecting casings and then ran inside to one of the rooms. W.G-M. said that he saw the individual who was shooting at them and knew who the suspect was. W.G-M. stated that he has known the shooter for about a year and has seen him more than ten times. He indicated that his street name was "Tank". Officers showed W.G-M. a photograph and he positively identified the photo as "Tank" and the same individual who shot at him. W.G-M. indicated he was 100% positive.

Subsequent investigation revealed that the Defendant had an active warrant out for his arrest on a pending felony weapons charge, MNCIS# 27-CR-16-19474. Officers have been searching for the Defendant since July 18, 2016.

On August 18, 2016, at approximately 1852 hours, Minneapolis Police conducted a routine traffic stop near 26th Ave N & Lyndale Ave N in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota. Officers recognized the front passenger of the vehicle as the Defendant from a Minneapolis Police Daily Information Brief as being wanted for a weapons charge. When they attempted to identify him, the Defendant claimed he was Shamy Antonio Ford with a DOB: of 5/5/98. Officers were able to confirm that this information was false and that he was actually MARQUISE TREVONE HAMMONDS-FORD, DOB: 9/6/95, the Defendant.

Officers placed the Defendant under arrest and transported him to the Hennepin County Jail.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS
