COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

Amended

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - With Intent-Not Premeditated

Minnesota Statute: 609.19.1(1), with reference to: 609.11.5(a), 609.05.1, 609.05.2, 609.19.1

Maximum Sentence: 40 YEARS

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/13/2017

Control #(ICR#): 17219010

Charge Description: That on or about 6/13/2017, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, ARMAJEA KEYVON WARREN, acting alone or intentionally aiding, advising, hiring, counseling or conspiring with another or otherwise procures the other to commit the crime, caused the death of A.Y., a human being, with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation, while using a firearm.

Minimum Sentence: 3 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

AMENDED TO CLARIFY FACT SECTION

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On June 13, 2017, officers were called to the area of 26th Avenue North and Knox Avenue North, City of Minneapolis, County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, on a report of a shooting. Officers arrived and found a gray SUV crashed. Inside was A.Y., a known adult male. A.Y. was in the driver's seat and observed to have what appeared to be a gunshot wound to the left side of his head behind his ear. A.Y. was declared dead at the scene.

Officers began the investigation at the scene. This included interviewing individuals in the area who heard gunshots. During this process, a known individual who will be identified as "Witness A" came to the scene. Witness A told officers that Witness A had been in the car with A.Y. at the time of the incident. Witness A stated that two females, identified herein as "Person 1" and "Person 2," were also in the vehicle. Witness A stated that they were in the area as Person 1 wanted to purchase marijuana. Witness A stated that Person 1 and Person 2 left the vehicle and returned a short time later along with three males. One of these individuals was identified as ARMAJEA KEYVON WARREN, "Defendant" herein. The other two males are identified herein as "Suspect 1" and "Suspect 2."

Witness A reported that Person 1 and Person 2 got back inside the SUV and Defendant also got in the back passenger side. Witness A reported that Defendant pulled a handgun out and pointed it at A.Y. Defendant then stated, "Give me everything." Witness A pushed Defendant's arm back such that the handgun was no longer pointing at A.Y. However, Suspect 1 then pulled out a handgun and shot A.Y. in the head. Witness A grabbed the steering wheel of the vehicle and pushed the accelerator with his other hand to drive away. Defendant, Suspect 1, Suspect 2, Person 1, and Person 2 all fled the area. Witness A continued trying to drive until the vehicle crashed as he was looking down. Witness A then fled the scene to report what had happened. Witness A told officers a female voice yelled "Kill his ass" as Witness A was trying to drive away.

Officers met with Person 1 and Person 2. Each individual provided limited information to officers regarding the incident, but confirmed their presence at the scene. Officers additionally met with Defendant. Defendant admitted his involvement to officers, including pulling the handgun and demanding property from A.Y. and Witness A before Suspect 1 shot A.Y. Officers learned that the handguns were retrieved from Suspect 1's residence. One handgun was carried to the scene by Defendant while the other was carried by Suspect 2. Suspect 2 turned over the handgun to Suspect 1 before Suspect 1 shot A.Y.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
