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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent**

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(1)

Maximum Sentence: 20 YEARS AND/OR \$100,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 01/30/2018

Control #(ICR#): 18031276

Charge Description: That on or about 1/30/2018, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, EMITT LEON LONG intentionally and without claim of right, took, used, transferred, concealed or retained possession of movable property belonging to (victim) without consent and with the intent to deprive the owner/entity permanently of possession of the property, and the property had a value in excess of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00).

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

That on January 30, 2018 at approximately 9:48 p.m., Minneapolis police were dispatched to 3rd Street and 4th Av S on a call of a theft from a motor vehicle. Upon arrival, police met with the witness, a male identified as P.G. He reported that he was walking in the area and saw a male later identified as Defendant herein, Emitt Leon Long, age 46 DOB 4-19-71, get out of green sedan with license plate number 524 HXW, walk up to a parked car and take items out of the car through a window. The witness reported that Defendant put the bags in his green sedan and drive away. The witness gave a description of the thief. Police observed glass on the ground from a broken rear passenger side window.

As police were talking with the witness, the owners of the car approached. They identified the car as theirs and indicated that bags containing technical equipment were missing, valued in excess of \$35,000.00.

Officers traced the suspect vehicle's registration to an address in Robbinsdale. Upon arrival at the residence, a townhouse, police saw the suspect car on the street. As police were talking with the homeowner, the Defendant walked out of the house. The Defendant matched the description given and he was arrested.

After his arrest, police interviewed Defendant. After having been advised on his rights, Defendant agreed to questioning. He told police he was driving on 3rd Street in Minneapolis when he saw a car and decided to pull in behind it and steal whatever was inside. He told police he used a screwdriver to break a window and he reached in through the window and grabbed a large bag of items. He then grabbed two more bags and left the area. He looked at what he had stolen and decided to discard the equipment in a dumpster in a townhouse complex near his girlfriend's residence in Robbinsdale. Police recovered the missing items from the dumpster. The screwdriver was also recovered.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
