The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

Charge Description: That on or about 2/16/2018, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, ANTONIO TONY CLARK possessed ammunition or a firearm and ANTONIO TONY CLARK has been convicted or adjudicated delinquent in this state or elsewhere of crimes of violence: third degree drug sale, 27-CR-90-056054, assault in the first degree, 27-CR-95-106949, and prohibited person in possession of a firearm, 27-CR-07-123620, for which the sentence or court supervision expired on or after August 1, 1993.

Minimum Sentence: 5 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Your Complainant is an Investigator with the Minneapolis Police Department, and in that capacity has investigated the facts and circumstances of the offense alleged herein, including reviewing the reports of other officers, and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On February 16, 2018, officers were dispatched to a home in the 3500 block of Lyndale Avenue North, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, on a report of a shooting. Responding officers were led by a witness to the basement of the residence, where A.C., an adult male, Victim herein, was found deceased, slumped inside a closet with his back partially against the wall. A small caliber handgun was found next to Victim. Officers learned through investigation that Victim had been shot by ANTONIO TONY CLARK, Defendant herein, Victim's brother.

Officers spoke with Witness A, a known adult female, who was Victim's girlfriend. Witness A stated that she and Victim had been in front of the house, and she saw a man entering the house with a large handgun, which she believed to be a .45 caliber handgun. Witness A stated that Victim went after the man into the house and that a short time later, she heard three small taps, which she recognized as gunshots from a smaller gun, followed by several louder taps, which she recognized as gunshots from a larger gun such as a .45 or a 9mm handgun. Witness A then saw a red truck drive away. Witness A participated in an identification procedure in which she confirmed that the man she saw enter the home was Defendant.

Investigators also spoke with Witness B, a 9 year old juvenile male, who was Victim's son. Witness B stated that he had been in the living room of the residence when his uncle, "Big T," a known nickname for Defendant, entered the home looking for a third party, after having arrived in his red truck. Witness B stated that Defendant pulled out a black and silver colored handgun and went into the basement, followed by Victim. Witness B heard Victim tell Defendant to leave Victim's home, and then heard a series of gunshots coming from the basement.

Officers spoke with Witness C, a known adult female, who was present in the basement of the residence at the time of the shooting. Witness C stated that she had been watching television with her baby in a room that was behind a curtain in the basement, when she saw Defendant poke his head around the curtain, looking for somebody. Witness C then heard Defendant and Victim arguing, and Victim telling Defendant to get out of his house. After that, Witness C stated that she heard three gunshots, and heard Defendant state, "my brother just shot at me." Witness C then heard several more gunshots and heard Victim say, "my brother just shot me," and then heard Victim slide down the wall and heard footsteps go up the stairs.

Officers responded to North Memorial Hospital, where Defendant had been dropped off in a red truck and walked into the emergency room a few minutes after the shooting at Victim's house to be treated for non-life threatening gunshot wounds. Officers spoke with Defendant, who presented several different explanations for his and Victim's injuries, including that they had been robbed by an unknown third party in the basement and that the home had been filled with fifteen "dope fiends."

An examination of the basement area where the shooting took place revealed discharged cartridge casings consistent with Victim having fired from a small gun while backed into a closet area and Defendant having fired from a larger gun in the basement area by the stairs, consistent with the description of shots provided by Witness A. A small caliber handgun was recovered next to Victim's body. The larger gun, which fired the shots that killed Victim, has not been recovered, but the discharged cartridge casings in the area of the basement where Defendant is believed to have been standing are consistent with being fired from a larger caliber handgun.

Defendant has been convicted of third degree drug sale, 27-CR-90-056054, assault in the first degree, 27-CR-95-106949, and prohibited person in possession of a firearm, 27-CR-07-123620, and is therefore prohibited from possessing a firearm.

Defendant is in custody.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or

(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
