The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Murder - 2nd Degree - With Intent-Not Premeditated

Minnesota Statute: 609.19.1(1), with reference to: 609.11.4, 609.19.1, 609.11.9

Maximum Sentence: Forty years.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 01/03/2019

Control #(ICR#): 19002972

Charge Description: That on or about January 3, 2019, in Hennepin County, Minnesota, QUINTEN LAVEL OSGOOD JR, caused the death of A.M., a human being, with intent to effect the death of that person or another, but without premeditation, while using a dangerous weapon.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

On or about January 3, 2019, at approximately 10:41 p.m. officers with the Minneapolis Police Department were dispatched to the area of 35th Street East and 1st Avenue South, Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, on the report of a stabbing. Upon arrival, officers found the adult male victim A.M. unconscious and observed that the victim was bleeding profusely from a chest wound. Medical intervention was attempted on the victim but he subsequently died from his injuries.

Officers spoke to witness S.W. S.W. informed officers that she lives with the victim. The victim and S.W. invited two friends to their residence for a party. S.W. stated initially the party was pleasant and everybody was getting along. At some point in the evening, the victim and QUINTEN LAVEL OSGOOD JR, the Defendant herein, got into an argument over music. The victim ordered Defendant to leave the residence. Defendant became angry and stormed out of the residence. Once outside the residence, Defendant kicked the gate to the fence so hard that it caused damage to the gate. The victim confronted Defendant about the damage to the gate. A physical fight ensued between the victim and Defendant. The victim and Defendant were fighting on the ground and eventually they both stood up. Defendant fled the scene on foot and the victim tried walking to the residence but collapsed.

Officers spoke to witness B.A. B.A. told officers that she went to the victim's residence with Defendant for a party. The party was pleasant until the victim and Defendant got into an argument over music. The argument escalated and the victim ordered Defendant to leave the residence. Defendant then left the residence. B.A. did not see the fight as she remained in the residence.

Officers spoke to two other known witnesses. Both witnesses informed officers that they observed the victim and Defendant fighting on the ground. The victim stood up and tried to walk away but stumbled and collapsed to the ground. Defendant then stood up and took off running in the opposite direction of the victim.

In a post-Miranda statement Defendant informed investigators that he attended a party at the victim's residence. Initially the victim and Defendant were getting along. At some point in the evening, the victim and Defendant got into an argument over music. Defendant decided to leave the residence. Defendant kicked open the gate to the fence while he was leaving. The victim confronted Defendant about kicking the gate and a physical fight ensued. During the fight, the victim and Defendant fell to the ground. Defendant saw a knife on the ground, Defendant picked up the knife and stabbed the victim with the knife. Defendant then ran from the scene.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office informed investigators that the victim suffered three stab wounds: two to his left chest and one to his left buttocks.

The knife used in the incident was never recovered.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or

(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
