COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-1st Degree-Use of deadly force against peace officer/prosecutor/judge or correction employee

Minnesota Statute: 609.221.2(a), with reference to: 609.101.2, 609.221.2(a), 609.221.2(b)
Maximum Sentence: 20 YEARS AND/OR \$30,000, WITH NO SUPERVISED RELEASE
Offense Level: Felony

Charge Description: That on or about January 7, 2020, at a residence on the 12200 block of Pineridge Way, City of Dayton in Hennepin County, Minnesota, FARIS M T HUSSIEN, while using a dangerous weapon assaulted victim 1, a peace officer by using or attempting to use deadly force against the officer, while victim was engaged in the performance of his or her duties imposed by law, policy or rule.

Charge Description: That on or about January 7, 2020, at a residence on the 12200 block of Pineridge Way, City of Dayton in Hennepin County, Minnesota, FARIS M T HUSSIEN, while using a dangerous weapon assaulted victim 3, a peace officer by using or attempting to use deadly force against the officer, while victim was engaged in the performance of his or her duties imposed by law, policy or rule.

Minimum Sentence: 10 YEARS

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Complainant has investigated the facts and circumstances of this offense and believes the following establishes probable cause:

That on or about January 7, 2020, Officers were attempting to execute a search warrant at a residence on the 12200 block of Pineridge Way, City of Dayton, Hennepin County.

Two Police Officers in discharge of their official duties, Victim 1 and Victim 2 herein, approached the front door of the residence while a third Police Officer, Victim 3 herein, was nearby to the side. Victim 2 knocked on the door and announced himself as a Police Officer. The individual inside, later identified as FARIS M T HUSSIEN, Defendant herein, locked the door's dead bolt lock. At this time, officers determined they would kick in the door. Upon doing so, Defendant aimed a firearm at the victims and fired multiple rounds in their direction. Victim 1 had five bullet holes in his clothing, four in his jacket and one in his pant leg. During the incident, Victim 2 returned fire at Defendant. None of the individuals involved sustained injuries.

At present, Defendant is in custody.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
