SYNOPSIS:

This report pertains to the cleaning of 2760 Louisiana Ct #7 St. Louis Park, MN and the return of both keys for this apartment to Jacob Flaschenriem on 1-29-2019. Additionally this report details a follow up unrecorded phone conversation with Mylee Jane Workman DOB 7-8-1981 via cell phone number 763-219-2183 with Det. Nybeck after the apartment was cleaned. Refer to all reports and attachments in this case file for greater details.

OFFICERS INVOLVED:

From the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Investigative Division: Det. Nybeck

NARRATIVE:

On 1-29-2019 and at approximately 8:44am Det. Nyebck met with Flaschenriem and took possession of a key fob that would allow access into 2760 Louisiana Ct. Det. Nybeck was advised by Det. Nestrud that Flaschenriem was the building manager for this apartment complex. At this time Det. Nybeck turned over one key that would allow building management access into apartment #7 (Workman's apartment) for this address. Flaschenriem subsequently signed the chain of custody form for this apartment key.

At approximately 8:45am Det. Nybeck met with Restoration Contractors. Det. Nybeck entered 2760 Louisiana Ct #7 with Restoration Contractors and escorted them to the left rear bedroom for this apartment. At this time Det. Nybeck showed Restoration Contractors what needed to be cleaned.

At approximately 9:15am Det. Nybeck was advised by Restoration Contractors that their work inside apartment #7 was completed and that they were ready for an inspection of their work. Det. Nybeck proceeded to enter and visually inspect apartment #7. Det. Nybeck observed that there did not appear to be any signs of damage or need for additional clean up in the left rear bedroom in apartment #7. Det. Nybeck observed a red stain on the floor in the left rear bedroom but was advised that this observed stain was between the wood and the floor's coating (pre-existing). Det. Nybeck further observed a red discoloration in the entry by the front door but was able to determine that it was not related to the incident from 1-19-2019.

After the inspection of apartment #7 Det. Nybeck locked the front door for the apartment and met again with Flaschenriem and turned over the second door key for apartment #7 to him. Flaschenriem again signed for the second door key for this apartment. Flascheniem's signature is on the chain of custody form. The chain of custody form for both front door keys for apartment #7 is attached to this case file for evidentiary value.

At approximately 9:55am Det. Nybeck contacted Workman via cell phone 763-219-2183 and advised

her that she can enter apartment #7 at her convenience and take whatever possessions she chooses. Workman was advised that Flaschenriem has possession of both apartment keys and that she will need to contact him to arrange a time to take possession of one of the two apartment keys. Det. Nybeck provided Workman with Flaschenriem's name and contact number (763-221-4236).

Workman asked Det. Nybeck about specific details regarding the overall investigation. Workman was advised that by Det. Nybeck that he cannot speak about it in any detail. Det. Nybeck advised Workman that the investigation is still ongoing and that it will be reviewed by the Hennepin County Attorney's Office at a later time. Workman thanked Det. Nybeck for having apartment #7 cleaned and informing her that she could now enter the apartment. Workman stated that she will be discontinuing payment on her personal phone that is now in possession of Law Enforcement and that she wanted to let Det. Nybeck know this so that Law Enforcement does not think she is being "difficult". Workman further stated that "Matthew" (Matthew Neil Tuhkanen DOB 8-4-1983) often texted her personal phone from multiple phone numbers and that it may be difficult to discern which text messages came from him. Workman further stated that "Matt's" text messages may indicate that he was suffering from mental illness and psychological problems.

Workman acknowledged the red stain on the floor in the left rear bedroom and on the floor in the entry way. Workman stated that both stains were present when she initially began to rent to apartment and both stains were documented by management at that time.

Prior to the end of this phone call Det. Nybeck advised Workman to call him should she have any questions or issues when she returns to her apartment.

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

On 3-21-2019 Det. Nybeck signed for and took possession of evidence items #29-31 and #6 from Computer Forensics Services (CFS) located at 601 Carlson Pkwy #1250 Minnetonka, MN. At this time Det. Nybeck was notified by Jason Heilman of CFS that they were not able to extract data on evidence items #6 and #31. Heilman stated that an extraction was successful on evidence item #29 (Mylee Workman's phone) and the SD card for evidence item #30 (from Officer Heffernan's work cellular phone). Heilman stated that the retrieved data from these two items are stored on the accompanying CDs (2x) provided to Det. Nybeck along with the evidence items. The two CDs are attached to the main case file for evidentiary value.

Det. Nybeck transported the above listed items of evidence directly to the locked and secured Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Crime Lab for permanent storage. A copy of CFS' chain of custody form and Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Crime Lab forms are attached to the main case file for evidentiary value.


On 3-22-2019 Det. Nybeck reviewed the CDs provided by CFS. Both CDs are identical. In review of the data from Officer Heffernan's SD card from his work cellular phone Det. Nybeck did not observe any data (calls, text messages, emails, pictures, etcetera) from 2019. The data observed related to Officer Heffernan was for pictures of the a female, random pictures with humorous captions (work and social) and the posting of items for sale.

In review of Workman's data included on the same CD Det. Nybeck observed random pictures of Matthew Neil Tuhkanen DOB 8-4-1983 and a young child in what appeared to be Workman's apartment located at 2760 Louisiana Ct #7 St Louis Park, MN. These pictures were dated 1-6-2019 and 1-17-2019. Det. Nybeck was able to review the call log of Workman's cellular phone on 1-19-2019 and observed that Workman was in repeated contact with a phone number she identified as "Tuhkanen" beginning on 1-18-2019 at approximately 7:03pm to 5:53pm on 1-19-2019. Additionally Workman's cellular phone called Emergency 911 at 5:02pm and 5:09pm on 1-19-2019. After these

two calls to Emergency 911 Workman called "Tuhkanen" an additional four times with the last call to "Tuhkanen" at $5:53 \,\mathrm{pm}$.

On 3-26-2019 Det. Nybeck reviewed and summarized the HC ME CODH report for Tuhkanen. The HC ME case number for their CODH report is 19-0460. This report is a summary of Det. Nybeck's review of the HC ME CODH report. The complete HC ME CODH report is attached to this case file for review and evidentiary value.

In review of the HC ME CODH report Det. Nybeck observed that Tuhkanen's manner of death is listed as "Homicide". Further review of this report indicates that Tuhkanen's blood had a concentration of ethanol listed as .103 g/dL, was positive for methamphetamine at a concentration of .33 mg/L and positive for methadone at a concentration of .01 mg/L. Additionally Tuhkanen's blood contained a detectable amount of Bupropion (anti-depressant and smoking deterrent).

INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

SYNOPSIS:

This report is a summary report of all investigative measures taken by the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Investigative Division as a result of the investigation for the death of Matthew Neil Tuhkanen DOB 8-4-1983 at 2760 Louisiana Ct #7 St. Louis Park, MN on 1-19-2019. Additionally this report will summarize the facts and action of responding Law Enforcement Officers prior to the death of Tuhkanen. Refer to all reports and attachments in this case file for greater details.

OFFICERS INVOLVED:

From the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Investigative Division: Det. Nybeck

NARRATIVE:

On 1-19-2019 the St. Louis Park Police Department received an emergency 911 call from Mylee Jane Workman DOB 7-8-1981 regarding a verbal domestic she was currently having with her boyfriend Matthew Neil Tuhkanen DOB 8-4-1983 while inside her apartment 2760 Louisiana Ct. #7. As a result of Workman's 911 call multiple Officers of the St. Louis Park Police Department arrived at this address to handle this call. Responding Officers were unsuccessful in finding Tuhkanen since he had departed Workman's apartment and hid from Officers prior to their arrival.

Shortly after the initial Officers departed Workman's residence and apartment building, the St. Louis Park Police Department received a second emergency 911 call from Jessica Marie Stillday DOB 3-7-1981. Stillday is also a resident at 2760 Louisiana Ct. but in apartment #8 which is directly across the hall from Workman's apartment. Stillday had informed the St. Louis Park Police Department that Tuhkanen had returned to Workman's apartment, was currently inside arguing with Workman again and that he had active arrest warrants. Based upon this information Officers returned to Workman's apartment. Officers were aware of the previous call by Workman less than an hour earlier regarding Tuhkanen, Tuhkanen's noted mental health issues and Tuhkanen's active arrest warrants.

Officers arrived for the second emergency 911 call and initially spoke to Workman. At this time Workman advised Officers that Tuhkanen was in the back bedroom of her apartment. The Officers that then entered Workman's apartment were Officers Peek, Smith, Pacholke and Heffernan. These Officers conducted a systematic search of Workman's apartment for Tuhkanen beginning at the apartment's front door and ending at the back northeast bedroom where they encountered Tuhkanen. As Officers were making their way through Workman's apartment they were verbally identifying themselves and their intentions.

Officers then entered the rear northeast bedroom with Officer Peek entering first followed by Officer Heffernan, Pacholke and then Smith. Officer Peek first observed Tuhkanen in the rear southeast corner of this bedroom behind a dresser that ran along the south wall of this room and to the south of a bed that ran along the east side of the room's wall. Officers were staged diagonally, and at time in a

half moon circle, in this bedroom in an attempt to keep Tuhkanen in this area so he could be controlled and taken into custody. Upon entry all Officers had their assigned Tasers out, activated and pointed at Tuhkanen with the exception of Officer Heffernan who had his assigned firearm out and pointed at Tuhkanen. At some point in Law Enforcement's encounter, Officer Pacholke holstered his Taser and was ready to engage Tuhkanen with his hands if needed. Officers stated they did not engage Tuhkanen with their Tasers because of the clothing he was wearing. Tuhkanen was wearing loose fitting heavy clothing that would not allow for successful Taser deployment.

Because of Tuhkanen's location in this room and that the dresser and bed blocked their complete view of Tuhkanen, Officers could not see what was to Tuhkanen's left side and what was below his mid thigh area. Officers observed that Tuhkanen was in an emotionally volatile state, spoke in a loud aggressive tone, moved his body randomly and quickly and did not listen to Officers commands. Officers stated they repeatedly provided Tukhanen with explanations as to why there were there (arrest warrants) and what they expected him to do (comply with his arrest). Officers stated that Tuhkanen repeatedly moved his hands over and under his clothing despite Officers commands to comply with their orders. Tuhkanen was informed that if he does not show his hands he would be shot. Shortly after this statement to Tuhkanen was made, Officers stated that Tuhkanen quickly reached down and to his left, which was out of view of all Officers present, and was shot three times by Officer Heffernan. Officers stated they were between 4-10ft from Tuhkanen while in this bedroom.

After Officer Heffernan fired his service weapon Officers immediately notified emergency 911 what had occurred and requested medical assistance. Officers also proceeded to administer life saving techniques until EMS could arrive. Shortly after EMS arrived Tuhkanen was pronounced dead.

Officers Peak, Heffernan, Pacholke and Smith were escorted back to the St. Louis Park Police Department with escort Officers. The Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Detective Unit and Crime Lab responded to 2760 Louisiana Ct. #7 and the St. Louis Park Police Department. A search warrant was drafted for this address by the Detective Unit and Crime Lab. As the execution of the search warrant was occurring other Detectives conducted digitally recorded interviews of Workman and Officers Smith and Pacholke at the St Louis Park Police Department. Officer Peek provided a follow up digitally recorded interview with Detectives on 1-22-2019. Officers Peek, Pacholke and Smith provided follow up digitally recorded interviews on 2-21-2019 and 2-15-2019 (Smith and Pacholke) respectively. Officer Heffernan provided a written and follow up statements to Detectives on 2-5-2019 and 2-14-2019.

Detectives conducted digitally recorded interviews with all tenants of 2760 Louisiana Ct who were present on 1-19-2019 and a tenant of 2759 Louisiana Ct on 1-30-2019.

Included in this case file is the outdoor video surveillance for 2760 Louisiana Ct on 1-19-2019, all responding Law Enforcement agency reports and CAD notes, St. Louis Park Police Department Use of Force policies and training files for Officers, documented medical and incarceration histories for Tuhkanen and phone reports for the cell phones of Workman, Tuhkanen and Officer Heffernan.

All of the above listed interviews, reports and collected evidence are attached to this case file for evidentiary value and can be reviewed based upon the table of contents.

SYNOPSIS:

Securing the residence and scene at 2760 Louisiana Court, #7, and response to the incident scene.

NARRATIVE:

On 01/19/2018, I, Sgt. Bill Gottwaldt responded to the above residence to assist in the Death Investigation and Officer Involved Shooting, arriving a few minutes before 8:00 PM. I met at the scene with St. Louis Park Lt. Mikael Garland and Sergeant Balvin. I learned the shooting occurred around 6:16 PM, and their officers had been called twice that night, initially for a Domestic, and then returned after a neighbor reported the male suspect, later identified as the decedent Matthew Neil Tuhkanen, DOB 08/041983, had returned to the residence. Lt. Garland provided me a copy of their call history for that evening related to the call. (Refer to the attached for further details,)

I learned the involved officer who reportedly fired his service weapon along with three witness officers were already at St. Louis Park PD. I learned the woman and initial reporting party that lived at the residence were also at their police department. I learned that a neighbor who had called in to police to report that (Tuhkanen) had returned to apartment #7 is likely still in her apartment across the hall. I learned that officers have been keeping a log and controlling access into the apartment and later received the two original Crime Scene Logs.

I had HCSO detectives interview the neighbor who had called police and canvass and interview everyone in the apartments in the building. See the Detective reports for further details.

A search warrant was obtained for the residence, and the scene was processed by HCSO Detective, HCSO Crime Lab Investigators, and the Hennepin County Medical Examiners, and evidence was collected. See other reports for further details.

With the assistance with HCSO Crime Lab Investigators, they closed and with evidence tape sealed the bedroom in the apartment where the deceased had been located.

St. Louis Park Officer A. Forsman, who had been keeping the Crime Scene Log while I was there cleared at 1:31 AM when Crime Lab Investigators, and other detectives and myself were done in the residence. Officer Forsman turned over the logs to me. It appears an earlier log was begun by Officer Tim Olson of Minnetonka PD, until the log was transferred to Officer Forsman. It should be noted that Officer Forsman was writing down people allowed into the hallway outside of the apartment while also documenting who actually entered apartment #7 or the scene. (See attached)

Through assistance with St. Louis Park PD, I previously was able to contact Jacob Flaschenriem, a manager of the apartments for Perspective, Inc. I advised him we needed to secure the residence and change the locks to control access after we leave the scene. He identified himself to me as Louis Jacob Flaschenriem, DOB 05/25/1975, of 3381 Gorham Avenue, St. Louis Park, MN 55426, phone # 763-221-4236. He assisted in arranging for Floyd Security to come out and change the locks on the

At approximately 5:03pm on 1-19-2019 Law Enforcement Officers were disptached to 2760 Louisiana Court apartment #7 in relation to an Emergency 911 call for a verbal domestic. Law Enforcement Officers were familiar with this address and were aware that Matthew Neil Tuhkanen DOB 8-4-1983 resided at this address through previous Law Enforcement contacts. Additionally, Law Enforcement was aware that Tuhkanen had two outstanding misdemeanor arrest warrants. Law Enforcement Officers were futher aware that Tuhkanen has a history of violent behavior and mental illness(es).

Upon arrival at this address Tuhkanen fled the apartment and Law Enforcement Officers to an unknown location inside the apartment complex for 2760 Louisiana Court. Law Enforcement Officers were not able to locate Tuhkanen for approximately 39 minutes and subsequently departed the address without contacting Tuhkanen.

At approximately 5:57pm on the same date Law Enforcement Officers received a second Emergency 911 call for 2760 Louisiana Court apartment #7 related to a possible domestic assault in progress.

At approximately 6:12pm Law Enforcement Officers arrived at this address and encountered Tuhkanen inside apartment #7. At this time Law Enforcement aired to Disptach that Tuhkanen was non compliant.

At approximaltey 6:16pm Law Enforcement aired "shots fired" to Dispatch. Law Enforcement subsequently requested Emergency Medical Services to this address.

At approximately 7:22 pm your affiaint arrived at 2760 Louisiana Court apartment #7. Your affiant subsequently entered apartment #7 and viewed the inside of this apartment to include the back left bedroom. In the back left bedroom your affiant observed a white male identified as Matthew Neil Tuhkanen DOB 8-3-1984 laying on his back with what appears to be two gunshot wounds to his abdomen. Additionally your affiant was able to observe in

plain view two spent firearm casings.

Your affiant subsequenty learned that one Law Enforcement Officer had fired their service weapon inside apartment #7 during their encounter with Tuhkanen.

Your affant has subsequently learned from assisting Law Enforcement Officers that a witness overheard Tuhkanen and another occupant of apartment #7 discussing the possession of methamphetamine inside apartment #7 prior to the second arrival of Law Enforcement earlier today.

In order to process, document and investigate Tuhkansen's death scene your affiant is requesting a nighttime seach warrant be issued for 2760 Louisiana Court apartment #7 St. Louis Park, MN and for the body of Matthew Neil Tuhkanen DOB 8-4-1983 to search for all items listed within the scope of this search warrant.

Review the search warrant affidavit and property inventory form for greater details.

On 1-19-2019 the above listed Law Enforcement Officers were assigned the death investigation of Matthew Neil Turhkanen DOB 8-4-1983. Tuhkanen was involved in an Officer Involved Shooting inside 2760 Louisiana Court #7 St Louis Park, MN (residence) earlier that evening with the St. Louis Park Police Department.

Prior to the execution of this search warrant Det. Nybeck, along with other Law Enforcement Officers, entered the residence for Officer Safety purposes only, no searching of the residence occurred at this time. A copy of all individuals entering and exiting this residence is listed on the Crime Scene Access Log. The Crime Scene Access Log is attached to this case file for evidentiary value.

On 1-19-2019 and at approximately 10:45pm the above listed Law Enforcement Officers executed the search warrant for this residence and Tuhkanen's body. These Law Enforcement Officers searched for all items listed within the scope of the search warrant. Below are the listed individuals that assisted in the processing of the search warrant, the search of the residence and body and their assignments.

CSI Schiller was the primary CSI on scene

CSI Ware assisted in the sketch of the residence.

CSI Kipka assisted in processing the residence.

CSI Ballard conducted the photo scan of the residence and assisting in processing the residence.

Detectives Nybeck, Soeffker and Nestrud assisted in searching of the residence.

Items that were recovered as evidence were placed into separate evidence bags and sealed. After the evidence bag was sealed the recovering Law Enforcement Officer labeled the evidence bag with: what was found, who found it, where it was found, the case number and the date. All recovered items of evidence where then listed on the Crime Lab and search warrant property inventory forms. Evidence items numbered 1-15 were recovered by Crime Lab CSIs and documented per their policies and procedures. - 15. BC medication bottle from dresser in bedroom (EM15).
- 16. BC medication bottles in the name of Mylee Workman and MN ID for Mylee Workman. Found by Det. Nybeck in bathroom in vanity.
- 17. BC black purse with contents. Found by Det. Nybeck on floor in rear left bedroom.
- 18. EC suspected narcotics contained in paper. Found by Det. Nestrud in a book in the desk drawer west side of living room.
- 19. BC child winter jacket, child shoes and adult shoes. Found by Det. Nybeck in entry closet.

Evidence items 1-15 were retained by CSIs and transported directly back to the locked and secured Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Crime Lab for processing and storage. Evidence items 16-19 were transported directly back to the locked and secured Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Investigative Division for processing and storage by Det. Nybeck. Evidence items numbered 16-19 were placed into temporary storage locker #104 in the locked and secured temporary evidence vault in the Hennepin County Investigative Division.

Nicholas Burkhalter of the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office arrived at the residence to process, document and remove Tuhkanen from the residence. Turhkanen was transported to the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office pending his autopsy by N. Burkhalter prior to Law

Enforcement's departure.

A copy of the search warrant and search warrant property inventory forms were left on the kitchen counter top prior to Law Enforcement's departure.

As of 1-21-2019 2760 Louisiana Court #7 is considered a crime scene. Prior to Law Enforcement's departure on 1-20-2019 the locking door handle for the residence's front door (sole entrance) was removed and replaced with a new locking door handle and set of keys to prohibit entry and to maintain the integrity of the crime scene. The keys for the new locking door handle are retained at the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Investigative Division. Refer to Sgt. Gottwaldt's report regarding the replacement of the locking door handle for greater details.



OFFICERS INVOLVED:

Detective Stacy D. Braun #151, Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Investigative Division.

NARRATIVE:

On 011919, I, Detective S. D. Braun #151, was tasked with retrieving the work and personal cellular telephones from Heffernan, Sam at his residence. I rode with Officer Erickson, Jacob of the St. Louis Park Police Department to Heffernan's residence. I was told that arrangements were made for Heffernan to transfer custody of the phones to me.

Officer Erickson and I arrived at Heffernan's residence. Erickson contacted Heffernan and informed him that we were there. The garage door to Heffernan's residence opened. I exited Erickson's squad and met Heffernan in the garage. Heffernan had two phones in his hands. I asked Heffernan if he would like a receipt for his phones and he stated that he did. Heffernan handed me the phones. I was able to identify one phone as an iPhone and the other as an Android phone. I asked Heffernan if there were passcodes for the phones. Heffernan stated that the passcode for the iPhone, his departmental issued phone, was 286286. Heffernan went on to say that the Android phone, later identified as a Samsung Galaxy S8 plus and his personal phone, was a pattern. Heffernan showed me on the screen what the pattern was. I documented the pattern on a blank consent to search form that I was going to complete for Heffernan to sign. Heffernan asked if he could call his attorney and I responded in the affirmative. Heffernan took his phones, which were on the trunk lid of a car, and walked to the interior of the garage. Heffernan was on the phone within view of me, but I was not able to hear his conversation. Heffernan returned to the front of the garage where I was and indicated that under the advice of his attorney, he was not going to surrender either his departmental issued phone or his personal phone.

I contacted Lieutenant Lunde of the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office and informed him of the situation. Lunde stated that he would pass the information on and get back to me. I told Heffernan that I would be waiting for direction from my supervisors. Heffernan acknowledged my statement. I instructed Heffernan not to erase anything from either phone and that I would be awaiting instructions. Heffernan stated that he would wait in is house and that he would not erase anything from either phone. I retreated to the St. Louis Park squad with Erickson.

After a period of time, I was told that our office was working on securing a search warrant for Heffernan's personal phone and that Heffernan was going to surrender his departmental issued phone to Erickson. Erickson did retrieve Heffernan's work phone.

Detective McLouden arrived at Heffernan's residence. I exited Erickson's squad and entered McLouden's squad.

I was told a search warrant had been secured and that Detective Nestrud would be delivering it. I

contacted Heffernan's attorney and asked him to alert Heffernan that a search warrant had been secured for his personal phone and when the search warrant physically arrived I would be coming to his door to secure his personal phone. Detective Nestrud arrived with the search warrant. Nestrud, McLouden and I went to the door of Heffernan. Heffernan answered the door, was given a copy to the search warrant and surrendered his personal phone. Nestrud, McLouden and I cleared ourselves from the Heffernan residence.

Nybeck during the autopsy of Matthew Neil Tuhkanen DOB 8-4-1983 on 1-20-2019 at the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office located at 530 Chicago Ave S Minneapolis, MN. Additionally this report will include information provided by Dr. Myers and Palmer to Det. Nybeck regarding this autopsy. Dr. Myer and Dr. Palmer were the attending medical personal. Refer to all reports and attachments in this case file for greater details.

OFFICERS INVOLVED:

From the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office Investigative Division: Det. Nybeck and Det. Soeffker

NARRATIVE:

On 1-20-2019 the above listed Detectives were present for the autopsy of Tuhkanen at the Hennepin County Medical Examiner's Office. Tuhkanen was pronounced dead on 1-19-2019 while inside the rear left bedroom of 2760 Louisiana Court #7 in St. Louis Park, MN.

Upon arrival Det. Nybeck observed Tuhkanen placed on the Medical Examiner's table nude and fully visible. Det. Nybeck was familiar with Tuhkanen's physical appearance from viewing the picture of his current Minnesota Driver's License and observing Tuhkanen at 2760 Louisiana Court #7 on 1-19-2019.

Prior to the autopsy of Tuhkanen Det. Nybeck observed four gun shot wounds to Tuhkanen's body. The first gun shot wound was to the outside right deltoid. The second gun shot wound was to the front of the right deltoid (same deltoid). The third gun shot would was approximately three inches directly above his navel. The fourth gun shot would was approximately three inches above the third gun shot sound and approximately two inches to the right. Det. Nybeck was able to view Tuhkanen's body from all possible angles and did not observe any exit wound(s) for the above listed gun shot wounds.

Det. Nybeck did not observe any further injuries to Tuhkanen's body beyond old minor scars. Det. Nybeck did not observe any tattoos or identifying marks on Tuhkanen's body.

Det. Nybeck spoke with Dr. Myers and was informed that the Medical Examiner's Office was able to identify and account for all four expended firearm rounds in Tuhkanen's body.

The autopsy/Hierarchy report was requested for Tuhkanen's autopsy on 1-21-2019. Tuhkanen's autopsy/Hierarchy report will be reviewed and attached to this case file when it is made available.

I contacted Cheryl Cochrane, the Chief Financial Officer for Perspectives who advised me that the above address does have video showing both entrances. On 1-22-2019 I made arrangements with Cochrane and she advised me that they could download the video surrounding the time frame this investigation covers if I could provided them with a USB drive. I drove to Perspectives address located at 3381 Gorham Avenue, St. Louis Park and dropped off a USB drive with Cochrane. Cochrane advised me that the video would be downloaded and she would advise when it could be picked up.

On 1-23-2019 I was contacted by Cochrane who confirmed the video was successfully downloaded to the USB drive and was available for pickup. I drove to Perspectives address and took control of the USB drive with the video. I brought the USB drive back to the locked and secure storage of the Hennepin County Sheriff Investigative Offices located at 701 4th Ave S, Minneapolis.

On 1-23-2019 I began a review of the contents of the USB drive. The USB drive contained two video files and were labeled as follows 1) 2760 Back Door _20190119_160000 & 2) 2760 Front Door _20190119_160000. After reviewing the video no date or times were noted on the video. I then contacted Perspectives again and requested they check and see if they could download the video with date and times. On 1-29-2019 I was once again contacted by Cochrane who advised that they were able to download a video showing the date and time. The files were then downloaded to the USB drive. This time the USB drive contained 5 files.

On 2-6-2019 Det. Diederich took possession of and brought the USB drive containing the original video and door logs to the Hennepin County Crime Lab for storage. A copy of the Hennepin County Crime Lab Receipt has been added to the media section for future use.

At approximately 07:51 hours on 1/28/19 I, Detective Diederich conducted a phone interview with Jeffrey Stoll, who was Matthew Tuhkanen Parole Officer as well as his probation officer.

Stoll stated that he has had Tuhkanen on his case load for an estimated three years. The first year Stoll had Tuhkanen for a probation, then a probation violation were Tuhkanen was sent to the department of corrections for almost a year. Stoll stated that Tuhkanen got out on parole in the mid summer of 2018. Stoll stated that Tuhkanen's last charge was for 5th degree assault.

Stoll stated that he had weekly interactions with Tuhkanen either at his office or home visits when Tuhkanen had an address. Stoll stated that Tuhkanen showed up to the visits but had four parole violations since August. Stoll stated that Tuhkanen had warrants out of Anoka. One was for trespass and another other one for not showing up for court for a case still pending.

Stoll stated Tuhkanen's past violations resulted from drug use for methamphetamine over the past three years. Stoll stated Tuhkanen admitted that he had some mental health issues to deal with but had gone through some MDIC treatment, taking care of the of chemical and mental health issues through treatment while Stoll was supervising him.

Stoll stated that Tuhkanen had never said anything out of the ordinary and never mentioned anything about suicidal thoughts to Stoll.

Stoll stated that Tuhkanen was going to be on parole until July 2019. Stoll stated that Tuhkanen was homeless jumping from house to house. In closing Stoll stated that Tuhkanen was a regular client, who was on parole that struggled with some things but nothing out of the ordinary.

Interview concluded at 07:57 hours. Audio was uploaded to the case file.
